ASH MONDAY: Monday February 16th is Ash Monday, a day of total fast and abstinence. Holy Mass will be offered at 9:00 AM and at 6:30 PM, and ashes will be distributed at both Masses.

LENTEN REGULATIONS: Abstinence from meat & meat products is observed on Ash Monday and all Fridays of Great Lent. Abstinence is binding on everyone over the age of 14 years. **Fasting** from food and drink (except water and medicine) is observed from Midnight until Noon on **Ash Monday and Good Friday**. Fasting is binding on everyone between the ages of 18 and 60 years. Those unable to fast due to ill health must perform other penances & works of charity; like attending daily Mass, Stations/Benediction of the Cross and making charitable donations. There are no weddings during Lent.

LENTEN DEVOTIONS: On the **Fridays of Great Lent**, the **daily Mass** will be celebrated at **6:30 PM**, followed by the **Stations/Benediction of the Cross**.

ANNUAL BISHOP'S APPEAL: takes place during Lent. Details will follow in a separate mailing.

MEETINGS: 1) Pastoral Council on Sunday, February 8th at 12:30 PM in the Parish Center; 2) Sodality on Sunday, February 22nd at 12:30 PM in the Parish Center.

FEAST OF ST. MARON: Monday, February 9th is the Feast of Saint Maron, a **Holy Day of Obligation** for all Maronites, who must attend Mass on the Feast under pain of mortal sin. For the convenience of the parishioners, **the Feast day Mass will be celebrated at 6:00 PM**.

SAINT MARON'S DAY CELEBRATION: Our annual celebration will be held on Saturday evening, February 7th. The regular 4:30 PM Saturday evening Mass will be followed by a dinner in the Church Hall. The menu is traditional Lebanese cuisine home-made by the ladies of the parish. Tickets are only \$15.00 for an adult; \$8.00 for a child aged 4 to 16 years; and free for children under 4 years. Tickets will be on sale after all weekend Masses or from Maria Mackarey.
