SAINT ANN NOVENA: in anticipation of the Feast day of our Parish Patroness, begins **on Tuesday, July 17th**. On the weekend of July 21st and 22nd, the Novena will be prayed after the weekend Masses, and during the week it will follow the weekday Masses. The Novena may be made on any of those days at our parish or the Basilica of Saint Ann, which offers many opportunities every day for the novena.

FEAST OF SAINT ANN: is Thursday, July 26th. Since Saint Ann is our parish Patroness, her Feast is a **Holy Day of Obligation** for our parishioners. Bishop Gregory has granted us permission to **transfer the Feast Day to Saturday, July 28th at the regular 4:30 PM Divine Liturgy** to make it more convenient for our parishioners to fulfill their obligation to attend.

FESTIVAL NEWS: Cooking for our **24th Annual Lebanese Heritage Festival** will begin with the making of **stuffed grapeleaves on Monday July 16th, Tuesday July 17th and Wednesday July 18th**. Work will take place in the Church Kitchen and Hall beginning at **9:30 AM** each day and continue until the daily quota is reached. Many volunteers are needed on each of those days. A short informational meeting for the volunteer workers for the rolling of the grapeleaves will take place at the start of the first day of work.

MELKITE FESTIVAL: The Melkite Church needs help with their festival: in rolling grapeleaves on **Saturday, July 14th** and making kibbee on **Saturday, July 21st**. PASTOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES: Some people have questioned the source of the Pastor's authority. By Church law, the Reverend Pastor exercises the three-fold office of sanctifying, teaching and governing the parish. The Finance Council, Pastoral Council and Parish Consultants are advisory bodies to the Pastor. The Pastor represents the parish in all matters and is the administrator of all of the spiritual affairs and temporal goods (property and finances) of the parish. These responsibilities are contained in legislation passed by Pope Saint John Paul II, the Particular Law of the Maronite Church and the Eparchial Statutes of the Eparchy of Saint Maron of Brooklyn, and are the essentially same as those of the Pastors of Latin rite parishes in the Diocese of Scranton and all Catholic parishes in the world.
