

SAINT MARON NOVENA: The Holy Name Society is sponsoring a Novena for the Feast of Saint Maron. The Novena will begin on Saturday, February 1st and end on the Feast of Saint Maron, Sunday February 9th. On the two weekends of February 1st and 2nd and February 8th and 9th, the Novena will follow the regular weekend Masses; and on the weekdays of February 3rd through the 7th, the **weekday Masses will be at 6:30 PM** followed by the Novena. The Novena will include the recitation of the Holy Rosary, followed by a blessing of the Icon of Saint Maron and ending with the veneration of the relic of Saint Maron. A **plenary indulgence** may be gained by attending the Novena on the Feast of Saint Maron and fulfilling the usual conditions (Sacramental Confession and the reception of Holy Communion within a week before or a week after the Feast Day and praying for the intentions of the Holy Father).

SAINT MARON'S DAY DINNER: will be held in the Church Hall on **Sunday, February 9th**, after the 10:30 AM Mass and the Novena. The menu is home-made traditional Lebanese cuisine. Admission is \$20.00 for an adult; \$8.00 for a child aged 7 to 15 years; and free for children under 7 years of age. \$15.00 take outs are available for those not eating in the Church Hall. Tickets sold at the church office until February 7th and at the door on the day of the event. Parishioners are welcome to volunteer for prep and serving.
